2017 Scholarship Requirements

Candidates must meet the following criteria:

1. Be studying, or accepted to study, in one of the following fields:
 - 1.1 Engineering
 - 1.2 Science
 - 1.3 Computer Science
 - 1.4 Aviation Technology (e.g. A&P)
2. Be a resident of Ventura County.
3. Possess a minimum grade point average of 3.0 or equivalent.
4. Be enrolled or accepted in an accredited institution of higher learning. This includes community colleges, colleges or universities.
5. Be willing to be interviewed by the EAA Chapter 723 Scholarship Committee at its offices in Camarillo

The scholarship will be given directly to the student. The recipient shall be responsible for any tax due on the scholarship award monies.

The scholarship may be tax-free to the recipient if:

- **He or she is a candidate for a degree at an eligible educational institution; and**
- **He or she uses the scholarship funds to pay for qualified educational expenses such as tuition and fees, course-related books, supplies and equipment. Room and board, travel and non-required equipment are generally not considered qualified educational expenses.**

Please consult a tax specialist to determine your tax liability.

EAA Chapter 723 does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, creed, religion, national or ethnic origin, or gender. This scholarship is awarded based solely on merit and is not limited to pre-selected individuals.

2017 Scholarship Application Instructions

1. Complete the Application Form available at www.eaa723.org/scholarships.html.
(The PDF form may be filled out on your computer and printed.)
2. Provide an official copy of your school transcript.
3. Provide two (2) letters of recommendation. One letter or recommendation must be from a current instructor or faculty member or coach who can attest to your achievements, promise and character. The writer must sign and date the recommendation and indicate their title and relationship to the applicant. The recommendation should have been written no more than six (6) months before submission with the application for the EAA Chapter 723 scholarship.
4. Write an essay of no more than 1,000 words in length describing yourself, your educational and career goals and their relevance to, and furtherance of, an area in the field of aviation.
5. Double check that you have met **all** the eligibility requirements.
6. Clip all items together and mail or otherwise deliver in one envelope. Please do not use staples. Do not have letters of recommendation or school transcripts sent separately to EAA Chapter 723. They must be included in your application packet.
7. Applications must be received by May 1.
8. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
